

About Camp Trinity

Tuition

Camp Trinity tuition is \$260 for a half-day (morning OR afternoon), or \$470 for a full-day (morning AND afternoon). Full-day campers stay on campus during the midday break. Some courses require an additional materials fee. Tornado Athletic Camps have tuition pricing listed with each description. Tuition and fees are not pro-rated for late enrollment or for missed camp days.

Registration

Registrations are only accepted and processed through our online registration link on our Summer page of the Trinity website: www.austintrinity.org/summer. Payment is due in full at the time of registration. Activities have minimum and maximum camper count requirements. It is highly advisable that you register early.

What do I bring?

All campers should bring a refillable water bottle and snack. Full day campers will need to bring lunch each day. A general snack will be provided in the morning and afternoon. Emails with details specific to your camp(s) will be sent from our instructors prior to camp's start. Pack a swimsuit and towel on Fridays for our Splash Bash, an all-camp social with inflatable waterslides.

Staff

We employ our talented Trinity Episcopal School faculty and staff to lead our camp programs. We have experience teaching, serving our community, and are vigilantly dedicated to the education of young people. Our camps enlist the help of our Trinity alumni via our C.I.T. (Counselors-in-Training) program. C.I.T.s assist camp Instructors and engage with our campers in daily camp activities.
